



Cofrin Classic Invitational

Tuesday September 8, 2026

Concord High will be hosting the Annual Cofrin Classic at New Hampshire Technical Institute. As an 'early bird' invitational, this meet is perfect for gauging your athletes' fitness! The course is a flat, fast, and accurate 5km race over grass and gravel paths. There is no pavement anywhere along the course. The girls race will begin at 4:00, and the boys race at 4:45. JV and Varsity are NOT separated.

Participating teams should register on Direct Athletics. Timing services are provided by Granite State Racing Services.

Entry Fee: \$100 per school covers both boys and girls. (\$50 if only bringing one team). Checks should be made out to "CHS Athletics" and either brought to the meet or mailed to 170 Warren Street, Concord, NH 03301, Attn: CHS Athletics. Exit 15 E off I-93 onto I-393 East

Take Exit 1 off of I-393

Turn left at the light and follow straight into the NHTI campus. Buses can park in the large parking lot adjacent to the soccer fields.

Facility information:

- Buses and spectators should park in the large parking lot adjacent to the soccer field complex (Parking lot A)
- When buses are unloading, teams can use the Goldie Crocker Wellness Center restrooms. After that point, portable restrooms will be available in the tent city area. Athletes will be prohibited from entering any other campus buildings for any reason.
- Tent city will be by the gazebo in the lawn on the south side of Little Hall.
- The starting line is at the end of the field that runs adjacent to Fan Road. It is about a 5 minute walk from tent city.

- The race begins at the back of the field adjacent to Fan Road, runs for two laps around the pond, and ends behind Strout Hall.
- The course will be marked with large, obvious directional arrows and cones.
- **The entire XC area is a carry-in/carry-out area. Teams need to use the trash receptacles and help keep the area clean.**
